
You will be receiving a survey in the next few weeks. This is to help us get ideas to improve participation and how we can make CAA even better in the future.

# PROGRAM NEWS

The demonstrator for the May meeting is watercolorist Judith Hummer. She is also our judge for the *CAA Members Show* and the Yupo workshop demonstrator for May 15.

Judith Hummer states about her work and process that "many times my paintings will begin with an abstract base with no preconceived idea in mind. After my initial splashing and spattering has dried, I proceed to analyze it, turning the paper around until a subject pops into mind. Work then begins to

color, adding a different color, or creating different textures, all contribute to getting my idea across. This method helps keep my work exciting, fresh and full of energy. I have found that Yupo paper keeps my attention and broadens my creativity. There is never a dull moment when working on Yupo; it presents many challenges but also provides great rewards."

*Follow-up News* - Doug Safranek, our April guest artist, got back to me to say that it was a real pleasure to speak with our CAA group, which he called "a lively community of artists (who were) very engaged with what I had to offer them. It was a really fun evening indeed!"

I have also had several reports from members and board members who were in attendance on April 9, and all had good things to say. Linda Barboni said that Douglas was a dream to work with, and that the samples and historical overview of egg tempera he presented were fascinating. Almost everyone who saw the presentation expressed interest in trying egg tempera themselves. Mr. Safranak was apparently very persuasive and encouraging!


Judith Hummer Painting on Yupo Workshop
